What is a Facility Code?

A Facility Code identifies where a training participant works.



What will my facility receive?

A certificate, recognition on the Washington Project Firstline webpage, and staff who are trained in infection prevention.

5 Simple STEPS

1. Request a [Facility Code](#)
2. Have staff members enter the Facility Code in their user profile.
3. Tell staff to complete all six Washington Project Firstline training modules. Staff will receive 2 (free) contact hours for completing all six modules!
4. Close to 90%? Email ProjectFirstline@doh.wa.gov to verify. We will help make sure staff members entered the correct Facility Code.
5. Be recognized as a Frontline Infection Prevention Champion facility!
