RE: New DOH program to address environmental health issues associated with homelessness

In accordance with chapter 43.376 RCW, the Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989, and DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure, we invite collaboration with Indian tribes and tribal organizations in the development of policies, agreements, and program implementation that directly affects Indian Tribes and Tribal People. We are developing a new program to address environmental health issues associated with homelessness, which has the potential to impact Tribes and Urban Indian Health Organizations due to the disproportionate risk of homelessness among Tribal members and Native peoples in Washington.

Currently, the funding for the program is provided through Foundational Public Health Services to work with local health agencies to develop model programs addressing these concerns. Among other potential areas, we are exploring addressing conditions in encampments and shelters, promoting safer waste disposal, developing responses to extreme weather to protect people who are unhoused, and supporting availability of hygiene services. We welcome your participation as we prioritize areas for development.
