



Risk Factors for Late Onset Hearing Loss: In Utero Infection

In utero infections include:

TORCH infection

- **Toxoplasmosis**
- **Other infections - Syphilis**
- **Rubella**
- **Cytomegalovirus (CMV)**
- **Herpes Simplex if:**
 - **Newborn was diagnosed with neonatal herpes.**
 - **Mother had an active lesion during vaginal delivery.**
 - **Mother had an active lesion during a cesarean delivery with a premature rupture of membranes.**
