	Begin with an introductory statement about assessment.	
	Ask assessment questions based on participant's category, age, and feeding practices.	
	Use open-ended questions to learn about the participant's nutrition status, eating and feeding practices, concerns and interests.	
	Use probing questions to clarify information and get a more complete picture of the participant.	
	Assign nutrition risks and document risk notes when needed.	
	Ask questions to make sure a medical provider diagnosed medical conditions reported by the participant.	
	Determine when to use the "Not meeting dietary or feeding guidelines" risks.	
	Match the priority of breastfeeding participants and babies.	



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	Refer to the Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN) when a participant:  Is identified as high risk.  Has nutrition needs where seeing a RDN is valuable.  Requests a RDN appointment.	
	Wait to offer education until assessment is complete. Include:  All assessment questions answered  Growth or weight gain assessed  Blood test results evaluated	
	Write clear, concise notes to capture a complete picture of participant and communicate participant's needs, concerns, and interests.	
	Follow separation of duties policy.
